

A 45-minute seaplane flight north of Malé is the far-flung, turtle-shaped Velaa Private Island. Swoop down over sparkling turquoise waters to your very own slice of paradise, home to outstanding food, a 6,000-bottle wine tower and a divine Clarins Spa. Another must-fly-to island is The Brando on the distant French Polynesian atoll of Tetiaroa. The villas are drop-dead gorgeous, the seafood is meltin-the-mouth and it gets an extra thumbs up for running off renewable energy drawn from the sun and sea.

Recluses have never had it so good

If you're Caribbean bound and looking for pure unadulterated escapism, COMO Parrot Cay in the Turks & Caicos remains hard to beat. A favourite amongst A-listers, we're talking R&R central, especially if you hole up in its COMO Shambhala Retreat. Another top-to-toe feel-good idyll is Zanzibar's and Beyond Mnemba *Island*, accessible only by boat. We love the pristine white sands, authentic beach bandas and the whole vibe is deliciously low-key.

Last but not least is the oh-so-quiet **Song** Saa Private Island in Cambodia. The 27 eco-chic villas have been built from timber bought from villagers; driftwood has been carved into furniture and Khmer pottery revived to make the crockery. It's paradise with a conscience.

For ski and snow buffs, Whistler has a reputation for unsurpassed heli-skiing and boarding. Travel by helicopter to make fresh tracks on otherwise inaccessible vast powder fields and glaciers. Elsewhere in Canada, ascend frozen waterfalls away from the crowds amidst the breathtaking UNESCO World Heritagerated scenery of the Banff National Park. With one-on-one tuition, embark on a private tour and learn the basics of ice climbing.

Over in *New York*, you can't get more central than *The Knickerbocker*. Overlooking Times Square (and just steps from Broadway, Bryant Park and MoMA), when you're sat sipping a cocktail at St. Cloud rooftop bar, there's no mistaking where in the world you are. Beyond the bright city lights, *Ras Al Khaimah* is being touted as 'the next Dubai' and is only an hour's drive from its famous neighbour. *Ritz-Carlton* has nabbed a remote piece of desert here, an authentic location for its latest Arabian resort. Enjoy peace, adventure and luxury in equal measures.

The ONE for Immersive culture

Those looking for a more engaging take on local ceremonies and activities would do well to consider a Four Seasons beach/mountain combo in Bali. Check-in to Four Seasons Resort Bali at Jimbaran Bay and meet the curator of the resort's Ganesha Cultural Centre - a space dedicated to exhibitions and workshops in Balinese art, music and crafts.
